FTI IN FOCUS: THE TECHNOLOGY TALKS AUSTRIA START IN A WEEK'S TIME

The Technology Talks on 12 and 13 September in the MuseumsQuartier Vienna will bring together more than 700 people from science, business, industry and the public sector to discuss the future role of research, technology and innovation.

In a week's time, the Technology Talks Austria will begin, which - after 40 successful years in Alpbach - will now take place in Vienna for the first time. On 12 and 13 September 2024, Vienna's MuseumsQuartier will become a veritable campus for research, technology and innovation. The role of research, technology and innovation in the "triple transition" - the transformation of the economy in a sustainable, digital and human-centred way - will take centre stage in a contemporary mix of plenary events and workshops, which will be held together with numerous partners. More than 700 registered attendees will be able to take part in substantive and exciting debates with over 80 internationally renowned speakers.

The Technology Talks Austria are organised by the AIT Austrian Institute of Technology in close cooperation with the Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology (BMK), the Federal Ministry of Labour and Economy (BMAW), the Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research (BMBWF), the Austrian Research Promotion Agency (FFG) and the Federation of Austrian Industries (IV). More than 40 other partners from the technology community and the public sector are involved in the organisation of eight plenary sessions, twelve workshops, an exhibition and several side events.
